- All multimedia used in the classroom must either be provided by the Chief Academic
- 2 Officer, his/her designee, or have prior approval of the school principal.
- Movies, songs, or other multimedia may be rented or purchased for use in the classroom
- 4 for education purposes only. No movie, song, or other multimedia will be used for
- 5 entertainment purposes.
- When using multimedia in the classroom, all employees shall adhere to the provisions of
- the United States Code, applicable Board policy, and Board procedures regarding the
- 8 copying and/or use of copyrighted materials.¹
- 9 To define the fair and reasonable use of copyrighted work for educational purposes
- 10 without the permission of the copyright owner and reduce the risk of copyright
- infringement, the following guidelines are in effect:
- 1. In the case of computer software, the ethical and practical problems caused by computer software piracy shall be taught in all computer courses;
- 2. The Superintendent shall establish specific procedures regarding the copying, distribution, and use of copyrighted materials for instructional purposes;¹ and
 - Each school Principal shall establish practices which will enforce this Policy at the school level.
