- 1 The Bartlett City Board of Education operates a Sick Leave Bank for certificated
- 2 employees as authorized by and in accordance with state law. The purpose of the Sick
- 3 Leave Bank is to provide sick leave to teachers who have suffered an unplanned personal
- 4 illness, injury, disability, or quarantine and whose personal sick leave is exhausted.
- 5 To form a Sick Leave Bank, a minimum of twenty (20) teachers from the District shall
- 6 petition the Board for permission to establish a Sick Leave Bank. Upon approval, sick
- 7 leave bank trustees shall be appointed and shall operate as the governing body of the
- 8 sick leave bank and shall enact rules and regulations consistent with state law.<sup>2</sup> Teachers
- 9 wishing to participate shall initially give three (3) days of sick leave. These days are to be
- deducted from the teacher's personal accumulation and donated to the Sick Leave Bank.
- 11 All donations are nonrefundable and nontransferable.<sup>3</sup>
- At any time the number of days in the Sick Leave Bank is less than twenty (20), or one
- 13 (1) per teacher if there are more than twenty (20) members, or at any time deemed
- advisable, the Trustees shall assess each member one (1) or more days of accumulated
- sick leave. If a teacher has no accumulated sick leave at the time of assessment, the first
- earned days shall be donated as they are accrued by the teacher.
- A member may request an allotment of days (for the employee's personal illness or on
- account of an illness of his/her minor child) only in the manner designated by the trustees.
- 19 The need for these days must be verified by a statement from a doctor.<sup>4</sup>
- 20 By written notice to the trustees, a teacher may withdraw from Bank participation on June
- 30th of any year. Membership withdrawal results in forfeiture of all days contributed. A
- member who withdraws may re-enroll by so indicating on the approved application form
- 23 during the months of August, September, or October of the following year, by contributing
- the required donation, and in any manner so designated by the trustees.
