- The Superintendent or the Title I N&D Supervisor shall identify migratory students 1
- attending Bartlett City Schools, as required by law, and develop administrative 2
- procedures for ensuring that migrant students receive services for which they are 3

- students, Bartlett City Schools will:2 5
 - 1. Identify migratory students and assess the educational and related health and social needs of each student through an Individual Needs Assessment (INA).
 - 2. Provide a full range of services to migrant students including applicable Title I programs, special education, gifted education, vocational education, language programs, counseling programs, and other programs available to all children attending Bartlett City Schools.
 - 3. Provide migratory children with the opportunity to meet the same statewide assessment standards that all students are expected to meet.
 - 4. To the extent feasible, provide advocacy and outreach programs to migratory students and their families and professional development for district staff.
 - 5. Provide parents an opportunity for meaningful participation in the program.
- If a migrant student is identified by the district, the Title I N&D Supervisor shall notify the 17
- Tennessee Department of Education³ and request assistance if needed in the following 18
- 19 manner:

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- 1. Upload each qualifying Occupational Survey into the TN Migrant website; and
- 21 2. Notify the statewide MEP contractor.
